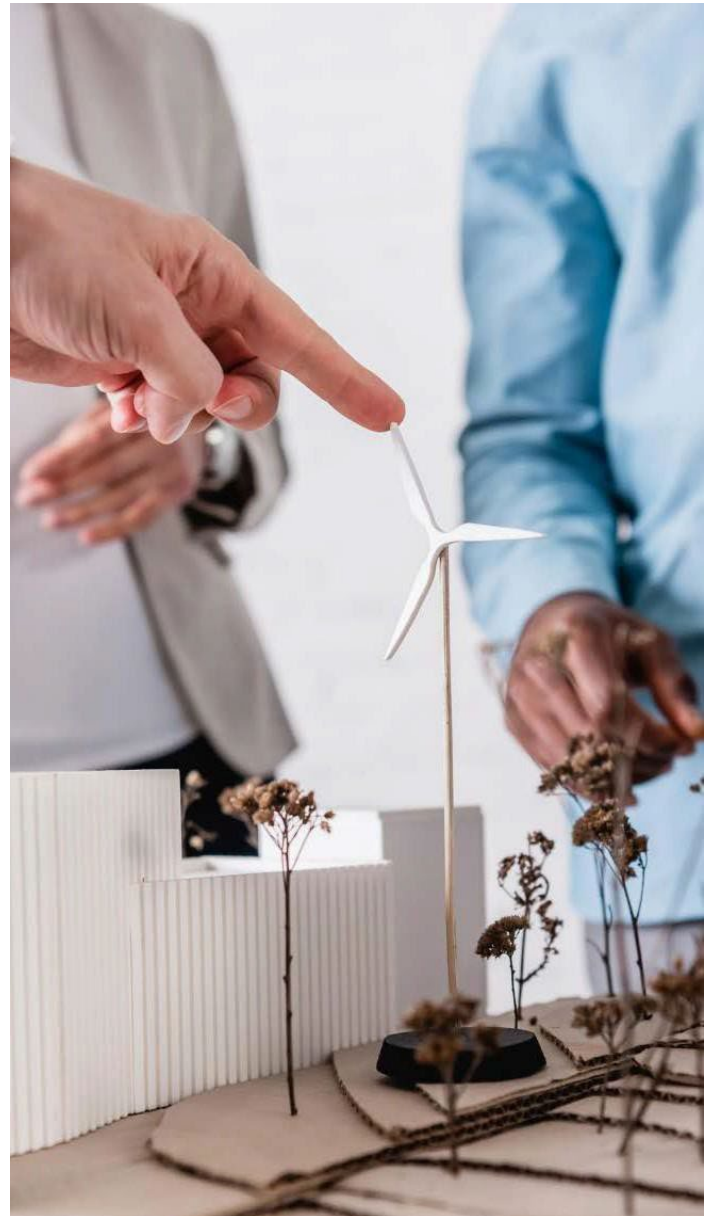
Cur síos ar an gCúrsa

Tá géarghá le hathrú paraidíme ar mhisean, cuspóir agus luachanna eagraíochtaí agus daoine aonair chun cur in aghaidh fadhbanna sóisialta agus comhshaoil amhail éagothroime rachmais, cailiteanas bithéagsúlachta agus athrú aeráide.

Freagairt radacach ar dhúshláin eacnamaíochta agus chomhshaoil is ea *Fiontair Bheo: Cuspóir, Straitéis agus Ceannaireacht*. Is é an Dr Fionnbarra Ó Brolcháin, údar agus ollamh, a dhear an cúrsa agus a chuireann i láthair é. Tá an clár seo, a bhfuil clú idirnáisiúnta air, bunaithe ar an dearbhú gur acmhainní cumhachtacha iad cultúr agus traidisiúin na hÉireann lena spreagtar brí, nuálaíocht agus cruthaitheacht agus lena gcuirtear sláine éiceolaíoch agus rathúnas eacnamaíoch chun cinn.

Tá sé mar aidhm ag an gcúrsa treoir agus tacaíocht a thabhairt do na rannpháirtithe chun tuiscint níos doimhne agus níos iomlánaíche a fháil ar conas a chruthaítear agus a roinntear luach, idir luach airgeadúil agus luach neamhairgeadúil, trí fhiontair inbhuanaithe atá bunaithe ar chuspóir a fhorbairt.

Pléitear réimse coincheap sa chúrsa, lena n-áirítear fíorluach, an nuálaíocht athghiniúnach, an t-ábharachas, an t-éiceadhearadh, an geilleagar ciorclach, an tomhaltachas eiticiúil agus neart eile. Lena chois sin, bíonn deiseanna ag na mic léinn leas a



bhaint as a gcuid taithí ar an obair agus ar aon saol chun cíoradh a dhéanamh ar na smaointe agus na hábhair a chlúdaítear sa chúrsa.

Déantar fiosrú sa chúrsa ar an ról ríthábhachtach atá ag an údaracht, ag an tuiscint ardhúiche agus ar an bhféiniúlacht i bhfiontair atá faoi úinéireacht an phobail agus lonnaithe i ndúiche faoi leith. Pléitear fiontair spreagúla in earnálacha an bhia, na n-ealaíon, na turasóireachta, an fhuinnimh in-athnuaite agus in earnálacha eile nach iad.

- Má tá tú ag iarraidh fiontar a bhunú, do chonair ghairme a athrú nó cur le do thacar sainscileanna laistigh den ról atá agat faoi láthair.
- Má tá tú ag dréim le dearcadh níos glaise ar shaincheisteanna eacnamaíochta agus comhshaoil laistigh de d'ionad oibre.
- Más mian leat a bheith mar chuid de líonra gníomhach agus nuálach de dhaoine gairmiúla a bhfuil an dearcadh céanna acu agus a bhfuil todhchaí athghiniúnach mar chomhspríoc acu.

Anailís a dhéanamh ar an gcaoi ar féidir le saol a bhfuil cuspóir leis a bheith ann mar thoradh ar fhiontair ghlasa trí chéim i dtreo sochaí agus pláinéad atá faoi bhláth a éascú.



Machnamh a dhéanamh ar conas saol maith a chothú a bhfuil brí dhomhain agus cuspóir leis, cé acu atá siad ag obair do dhaoine eile nó ag bunú a bhfiontar féin.



Fiontar glas samhlaíoch a phlé mar choincheap, a phleanáil agus a fhorbairt mar bhall de ghrúpa.



Tuiscint a léiriú ar an gcaoi ar féidir le pobal rathúil féintuilleamaíoch a bheith ann mar thoradh ar gheilleagar athghiniúnach áitiúil a bhfuil fiontair ghlasa mar bhonn faoi.

Reáchtálfar na ranganna ar líne. 24 uair an chloig ranga a bheidh sa chúrsa san iomlán agus mairfidh sé 12 sheachtain, le tosú Dé Máirt, 24 Meán Fómhair 2024.

Foghlaimoidh na rannpháirtithe trí mheascán de léachtaí, aoichainteanna, cás-staidéir, léitheoireacht agus plé ranga.

Course Description

Sustainable Ventures: Purpose, Strategy, and Leadership, offers a radical response to economic and environmental challenges. The course is developed and delivered by author and professor Dr Finbarr Bradley. The course delves into the critical role that authenticity, sense of place and identity play in community-owned and place-based enterprises. Inspiring ventures in sectors such as food, the arts, craft, tourism, renewable energy and more, are also examined.

Learning Approach

Classes will be held online. The course will consist of 24 class-hours in total, delivered over 12 weeks, beginning on Tuesday, 24 September 2024.

Participants will learn through a combination of lectures, guest talks, case studies, readings, and class discussions.



Assessment

Individual Assessment (50% of Grade)

Personal essay centring on self-reflection and self-transformation, drawing on content covered in classes and self-conducted research over the 12 weeks. The essay is due within a week of the last class session.

Group Project (40% of Grade)

Students engage as part of a group to conceptualise and develop an ambitious mock-up green venture throughout the 12 weeks of the programme. These ventures will be presented to the class and relevant stakeholders at the end of the programme.

Continuous Assessment (10% of Grade)

Class Participation and Homework.
